Pursuant to the authority granted to the Chief of the New Jersey Bureau of Securities ("the Bureau Chief") by the Uniform Securities Law (1997), N.J.S.A. 49:3-47 et seq. (the "Securities Law"), and after investigation of the facts involving Vincent Aloi, Triple A Construction, Inc., and United Consulting, LLC, (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Triple A Parties") in connection with the activities described in the Verified Complaint, Harvey v. Wellesley Services, LLC, et al., Docket No. ESX-C-188-03,¹ the Bureau Chief and the Triple A Parties, through counsel (Jan Alan Brody, Esq. of Carolla, Byrne, Bain, Gilfillan, Cecchi, Stewart & Olstein) now desire to resolve this matter and consent to the form and entry of this Administrative Consent Order.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Bureau of Securities ("the Bureau") is the state agency with responsibility to administer the Securities Law; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General of New Jersey on behalf of the Bureau Chief, Franklin L. Widmann, filed Harvey v. Wellesley Services, LLC, et al., Docket No. ESX-C-188-03 in June, 2003, whereby Louis T. DeLucia was appointed to be the Receiver by the Court; and

WHEREAS, the Receiver subsequently filed an independent action, Louis T. DeLucia, as Receiver for Wellesley Services, LLC et al. v. Thomas Giacomaro, et al., Docket No. BER-C-83-05 on June 4, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau has conducted an investigation and after review and due consideration of the facts into the Triple A Parties' activities, including the receipt of money, arising solely from the Triple A Parties' involvement with Wellesley Services, LLC, Wellesley Energy LLC and/or Consolidate Transport America, LLC and related entities and persons; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid the cost and inconvenience of litigation, the Bureau and the Triple A Parties have agreed to settle this matter, as well as any claims that the Bureau may have against Ricki Aloï and/or Northeast Distribution Services, Inc. (the "Other Parties"); and

WHEREAS, the Triple A Parties and the Other Parties do not admit to any liability for any claims arising from their involvement, if any, with Wellesley Services, LLC, Wellesley Energy LLC and/or Consolidate Transport America, LLC and related entities and persons, and solely for the purpose of settling this proceeding, prior to a hearing and without adjudication of any issue of law or fact, consent to the entry of this Consent Order and voluntarily waive the following rights for the purpose of this proceeding only:

- a. To be afforded an opportunity for hearing after reasonable notice within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 49:3-58(c)(2); and
- b. To seek judicial review of, or otherwise challenge or contest the matters described herein, including the validity of this Consent Order; and

WHEREAS, the Triple A Parties and the Other Parties agree for the purpose of this matter, or for any future proceedings before the Bureau to enforce this agreement, this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if proven and ordered after a full hearing held pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Receiver, the Triple A Parties, and the Other Parties have entered into a settlement and the Receiver is about to or has already filed a motion for the entry of an order approving the settlement (the "Settlement Order"); and

WHEREAS, this Consent Order concludes the investigation by the Bureau and any civil or administrative action that could be commenced under the Securities Law on behalf of the State of New Jersey as it relates to the Triple A Parties' activities arising from their involvement with Wellesley Services, LLC, Wellesley Energy LLC and/or Consolidate Transport America, LLC and related entities and persons and any such activity of the Other Parties, if any.

IT IS, on this, the 1 day of June, 2006 ORDERED:

1. Upon the entry of the Settlement Order and in accordance therewith, the sum of \$425,000.00 in immediately

available funds shall be paid to Louis T. DeLucia, the Court appointed Receiver for Wellesley Services, LLC and its related entities; and

2. In recognition of the payment of the sum of \$425,000.00 in immediately available funds to Louis T. DeLucia, the Court appointed Receiver for Wellesley Services, LLC and its related entities, in accordance with the Settlement Order, the Bureau agrees to forego the payment of any civil monetary penalty to the Bureau by the Triple A Parties and the Other Parties; and

3. The payment referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 shall constitute full payment and satisfaction of any claim the Bureau may have against the Triple A Parties and the Other Parties arising from their involvement with Wellesley Services, LLC, Wellesley Energy LLC and/or Consolidate Transport America, LLC and related entities and persons, if any; and

4. This Consent Order shall be null and void and of no further effect if the Settlement Order is not entered by the Court.
